COURSE SYNOPSIS

This course is designed for doctors interested in a live patient program where each case is thoughtfully treatment planned with the end in mind. This three-day program offers clinicians the opportunity to place implants and follow the results until the final restorations are completed. The focus is on comprehensive care rather than implant placement for the sake of experience. The faculty is comprised of prosthodontists, oral surgeons, periodontists, and credentialed expert general practitioners whose goal is to assist clinicians in expanding the scope of their implant practice and feel competent and confident in the field of implant dentistry.

AT THE CONCLUSION OF THE PROGRAM, PARTICIPANTS WILL BE TRAINED IN:

- Cone-beam interpretation, implant planning and pre-surgical digital diagnosis
- Reflecting flaps and atraumatic extractions
- An in-depth examination of the entire treatment planning process, rationale of treatment sequence and a full immersion in the surgical placement of dental implants
- Concepts of implant biomechanics, angulations and prosthetic basis of the surgical execution
- Manipulating bone in atrophic ridges
- Performing crestal approach subantral augmentation
- Autologous growth factors and the use of graft materials, membranes and PRF
- Placement of multiple implants, considerations for implant distribution and the facilitation of ideal prosthetic outcomes

- Those who attended short didactic courses and wish to consider placing implants in their practice
